So if you appoint a proxy for this meeting, be sure to indicate in the proxy statement your voting preference on this matter.

TRASH PICK-UP DAY MOVED TO FRIDAYS

Trash Day was moved from Mondays to Fridays. Place trash bins or bags at the curb on either end of the half-circle driveway (away from the building where the driveway intersects with Landings Way) no earlier than 5:00 p.m. on Thursday night. Bins or cans, if used, need to be returned to garages by midnight on trash collection day. Bulk items are authorized to be placed out on any Trash Day.

If any of the following national holidays falls on a Friday, then Trash Day will be moved to the **following Monday**. (On those occasions, place trash out no earlier than 5:00 p.m. on Sunday night.)
